The Centre for Research and Training in Municipal Administration was set up by the Union Ministry of Health, Family Planning, Works and Housing and Urban Development in January 1968, for conducting research and providing in-service training to Municipal officers from Uttar Prahesh, Bihar and Madhya Pradesh. The Centre has now completed three years of its working and the present report relates to the third year of its activities.

Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committee consists of the Secretaries of Local Self-Government of the states of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Madhya Pradesh, nominees each of the Union Ministry of Health, U. P. Government, Indian Institute of Public Administration respectively, Dean, Faculty of Arts, Lucknow University and Director and Professor in the Centre. The Secretary, Local Self-Government, U. P., is the Chairman while the Director of the Centre is its member—secretary.

During the year under report the Mukhya Nagar Adhikari of ucknow Municipal Corporation became the member of the Committee a place of Sri Sain Das Jain, as the nominee of the U. P. Government. The Secretaries of Local Self-Government of Bihar and Madhya Pradesk (Urban) were also included by the Government of India as new members of the Advisory Committee.

The Centre continued its normal activity of Research and Training in Municipal Administration and made Considerable progress in the field of Research. It is gratifying to note that the construction of Trainee's Hostel and Guest Suits are well under way.

Research

The following research reports were finalised during the year 1970-71:

(1) Working of Municipal Corporations in U. P.;

(2) A pliot study of 'Integrated Services for Youth and Children in Urban Areas', sponsored by the South Asia Division of the UNICEF which was undertaken by the Centre at the instance of Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi. The report of the pilot study was submitted to the I.I.P.A., New Delhi. The detailed proposal was finally approved by the Advisory Committee on February 27, 1971.

The centre has decided to undertake a study on 'The Working of Municipal Boards in Uttar Pradesh'. Accordingly a detailed questionnaire has been prepared and is being sent to all the Boards.

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Seminar held on Research and Training Requirements, the Centre has taken up the work of a clearing house. The background data relating to population, area, functions, development works etc. is being prepared and will be sent to the Municipal Boards of Uttar Pradesh by June, 1971.

Detailed information about the officials of Municipal Boards/ Municipal Corporations under the centralised service scheme has been collected and transferred on individual cards.

The Centre is actively thinking of starting a quarterly bulletin and a magazine containing news about the urban local bodies of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Madhya Pradesh. It is expected that its first issue will be published in the next academic session.

Publications

The Centre has finalised two research projects this year and they are in the Press, for printing:

- Problems of Managements and financing of Water Supply in Urban Areas.
- (2) Working of Municipal Corporations in Uttar Pradesh.

Diploma in Urban Government and Administration

The course was popular. Its performance was satisfactory and one student was placed in first division.

Training Programme

Three inservice training courses were held for municipal officers of the three States of U. P., Bihar and Madhya Pradesh during the year 1970-71.

The first course of the year and seventh in the series was inaugurated by His Excellency Dr. B. Gopala Reddy, Governor of Uttar Pradesh, on July 23, 1970. It was attended by seventeen municipal officers from Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh. The concluding function was presided over by Sri Chaturbhuj Sharma, Minister for Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh, on August 29, 1970.

The second course, and eighth in the series, was inaugurated by Sri Satrughan Saran Singh, Minister for Local Self-Government and Jails, Government of Bihar, on September 16, 1970 and was presided over by Sri Jagan Prasad Rawat, Minister for Local Self-Government, Government of Uttar Pradesh. Sixteen municipal officers from the three participating states of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar joined it. The closing function was presided over by Sri Virendra Verma, Minister for Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh, on October 24, 1970.

The third course and ninth in the series was inaugurated by Sri N. P. Bhatnagar, Secretary to Government Local Self-Government, Uttar Pradesh, on November 5, 1970. Ten officers participated in the programme. The closing function was presided over by Sri Roop Nath Singh Yadav, Minister for Local Self-Government, Uttar Pradesh, on December 16, 1970.

The names of the trainee officers who attended the three courses are given in Appendix I.

Conference and Seminars

A conference on "Role of Political Parties in Municipal Administration" was held on October 23 and 24, 1970 at the close of eighth inservice training course. It was inaugurated by Sri A. G. Kher, Speaker of the U. P. Legislative Assembly on October 23, 1970. The closing function was presided over by Sri Virendra Verma, Minister for Education, on October 24, 1970. The conference was attended both by officials and non-officials apart from the trainees of the eighth In-service Course.

The list of the participants of this Conference, excluding the trainees, is given in Appendix II.

During the year under report, three seminars were organised. The first seminar was held on August 27 and 28, 1970 at the close of the seventh In-service Training Course on "Centralisation of Municipal Services". It was inaugurated by Sri Jagan Prased Rawat, Minister for Local Self-Government. The Seminar was attended by the trainces of the seventh in-service training course and officials and non-officials of the three participating states. The names of the persons who attended the seminar (excluding the trainess) are given in Appendix III.

The second Seminar on "Problem of Water Supply in Lucknow" was organised towards the end of the ninth In-service Training Course on December 10, 1970, and was inaugurated by Dr. M. M. S. Siddhu, former Mayor of Lucknow Municipal Corporation. The second session in the afternoon was presided over by Mr. N. C. Chaturvedi, Advocate. It was attended by the trainees of the ninth course and other officials and non-officials. A list of the participants of this Seminar (excluding the trainees) is given in appendix IV.

Our interest in the discussions of urban problems brought us face to face with some of the problems faced by the Panchayati Raj institutions over the periphery of municipal areas. Recognising the need to probe into some of the common problems we held a Seminar on 'Problems of Panchayati Raj' on March 16 and 17, 1971. This was possible with the active financial assistance of the Directorate of Panchayat Raj, Uttar Pradesh, which we acknowledge gratefully. Sri Malkhan Singh, Minister for Community Development and Panchayat Raj, Uttar Pradesh, inaugurated the Seminar on March 16, 1971 at 11 A. M. and

Sri Jayaprakash Narayan presided over the closing fuction on March 17, 1971 at 3-30 P. M. Sri S. K. Dey, President of All India Panchayat Parishad, also addressed the Seminar and participated in the deliberations.

The Seminar was attended by the representatives of Research Institutions engaged in Panchayati Raj, eminent academicians, journalist and official and non-officials working under the Panchayati Raj bodies.

A list of the participants is given in Appendix V.

Evaluation of the training Programme

So far nine training courses, three each in the years 1968-69, 1969-70 and 1970-71 have been organised. In all 197 municipal officers have participated in these training courses. More than 3/4th, i. e., 152 trainees came from the urban local bodies of Uttar Pradesh.

The above table shows that only 9.3 percent of the Municipal officers of the centralized cadre in U. P. have been trained by the Centre since its inception. During this period the emphasis was laid on Administrative Services with the result that more than 1/5th of them have attended the training courses. About 19.6 percent of the Education Superintendents and 17.7 percent officials belonging to Audit and Accounts Services also derived the benefit of training programme. It is notable that no officer belonging to Medical and Arboriculture Services has attended the training programme so far.

The number of participants from the three participating states in the three courses, during the year 1970-71 is shown in the following table:—

About 67 percent of the trainees in the three courses came from Uttar Pradesh alone. However, there was an increase in the number of participants from Madhya Pradesh but a decrease from Uttar Pradesh and Bihar as compared to last year. There was an overall decrease of trainees as only 43 trainees attended the course as compared to 73 trainees in the last year. The decrease in number was due to the fact that there was a strike by the employees of the local bodies in the State of Bihar, when the courses were organised. The trainees from Uttar Pradesh could not come in full strength because of the proposed municipal elections in the State which were later postponed but only

after our training course had started. Apart from this the census operations also affected the number of trainees.

Attachments

In each of the three training courses, officers were divided into batches and they visited the following places:

- (i) Seventh Training Course
 - All the trainees went to Agra and Gwalior.
- (ii) Eighth Training Course
 - (a) Dehradun, Hardwar and Rishikesh.
 - (b) Partna, Gaya, Ranchi and Jamshedpur.
- (iii) Ninth Training Course

All the trainees went to Muzaffarpur, Motihari and Patna.

During the attachment period the traince-officers studied the working of Municipal Boards/Corporations/Improvement Trusts and allied agencies and submitted reports individually. The names of the trainceofficer who visited the above places including the staff members are given in Appendix VI.

The trainees were of the view that:-

- 1. The period of attachment should be increased.
- 2. The attachment should be outside the 'region'.
- 3. The attachment groups should be smaller.
- The attachment should be either at the beginning or at the end of training course.

Lecture—discussion

The names and designations of the guest speakers who addressed the trainees in the three training courses, are given in Appendix VII.

Syndicate reports

The trainees were divided into groups and allotted topics for preparing syndicate reports based on their study, experiences, mutual discussions etc.

The topics assigned for writing syndicate reports during the three courses were:

Seventh Course

- Committee System in Municipal Administration.
- Recruitment of municipal personnel in U. P., Bihar and Madhya Pradesh.

Eighth Course

- 1. Role of Executive Officer/Chief Municipal Officer.
- 2. Management of Public Works in urban Local Bodies.

Ninth Course

- 1. Administration of Food Adulteration Act.
- 2. Decentralization in Municpal Administration.

The participants were of the view that they should be provided with relevant literature and given enough time to prepare the report.

Case Studies

The trainees were required to prepare a few case study reports based on their personal experience. They were supplied with model case studies to guide them. The trainees were of the view that they should be informed well in advance to enable them to bring the facts of a case study.

Review of acts & statutes

The participants of the eighth & winth Courses were divided in batches for reviewing the municipal Acts, statutes, manuals and byc-laws of the three states. They prepared detailed reports on the following topics:

Eighth Course

- Assessment and collection of property tax.
- 2. Recovery of municipal dues.
- 3. State control of municipal boards/corporations.

Ninth Course

- 1. Municipal offences and prosecutions.
- 2. State control over urban loca! bodies.

Lodging

Currently lodging arrangement for the trainees is made at the M.M.S. Birla Hall, Moti Mahal, Lucknow. As soon as the construction of the trainees hostel within the University campus is complete, they will be lodged there.

Library

With a view to meet the growing requirements of trainee officers and research workers in the field of local government, urban planning and allied fields, a separate section containing books, pamphlets and reports on the above subjects has been created. It has been possible to further strengthen this section from the grant received from the Government of India and the State Government. A new feature of the Library is that it has started indexing of micro-literature, which are of immense value to the research workers.

Renovation of the Centre's building

The regional Centre is at present located in the old V. C. Lodge which needs immediate renovation. Accordingly, the State Government were approched to sanction necessary funds. A sum of Rs. 1,10,000/-has been sanctioned by the U. P. Government vide G. O. No. GA-1/138-U/15-5-8(6)/70 dated March 30, 1971. This generous help is gratefully acknowledged.

Hostel

As mentioned in earlier reports, a trainees-Hostel-cum-Guest House is at present under construction. The revised estimates for construction of

this hostel amount to Rs. 6,82,425/-. The construction work on the ground floor has been completed and at present construction on the first floor is in hand. The Hostel will have 33 furnished rooms with attached baths and five suites for the guests. The Government of Uttar Pradesh has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 6,82,425/- which is acknowledged gratefully. This grant was released in four instalments as under;

These contributions are gratefully acknowledged.

The Advisory Committee in its meeting held on May 5, 1970, decided to request the other two governments to make some contribution either themselves or by requesting the urban local bodies of their States to donate funds. A fresh appeal was also issued to the urban local bodies of the State of Uttar Pradesh to send in their contributions early.

The following are some of the important decisions taken by the Advisory Committee in its meeting held on May 5, 1970:

- (1) The Budget estimates of the Centre as originally proposed for the year 1970-71, were cut down from Rs. 1,35,500/to Rs. 1,11,500/- in view of the Government of India's directive in this regard. (A copy of the budget estimates for 1970-71 is given in Appendix VIII).
- (2) The Chairman of the Advisory Committee was empowered to re-appropriate funds from one budget head to another.
- (3) Out of the total intake capacity of 30 trainees in the Centre, seven seats were reserved for the nominees of each of the Governments of Bihar and Madhya Pradesh respectively.
- (4) It was decided that the centre should take up studies in selected Corporations of the three States and the concerned corporations should bear the expenses in this regard.

The following are some of the decisions taken by the Advisory Committee in its second meeting held on October 19, 1970:

- The Centre should take up the following programme for 1971-72:
 - (i) Three Inservice Training Courses.
 - (ii) One Seminar:
 - (iii) One Conference;
 - (iv) Some case studies:

- (*) Short-term courses for non-officials in the three States.
- (m) Conduct evaluation studies on the working of municipal bodies in the three states, if possible.
- The employees of the Centre were allowed to contribute towards the provident fund.
- The revised estimates for the Trainee's Hostel-cum-Guest House amounting to Rs. 6,82,425/ were approved.
- The Budget estimates for the year 1971-72 were approved as under:

 - (ii) Recurring grant by the State

 Government Rs. 50,100/-
- The Committee approved the purchase of a Jeep out of the contributions received from the local bodies of U. P.

The accounts of the Centre for the financial year 1969-70 were audited by Messrs. A Shah and Co., Chartered Accountants, Lucknow, as per Appendix IX and submitted to the Ministry of Health, Family Planning, Works, Housing and Urban Development, Government of India, New Delhi.
