The seventh Annual Report on the activities of the Regional Centre for Research and Training in Municipal Administration relates to the period of 1974-75. The Centre has completed seven years of its existence.

Director

Dr. R. B. Das, Professor and Head, Department of Public Administration, retired as Director of the Centre and Member-Secretary of the Advisory Committee on August 31, 1974. Dr. D. P. Singh took over as Director of the Centre from September 1, 1974.

Chairman, Advisory Committee

Sri Athar Husain, Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Local Self-Government, Uttar Pradesh, continued as Chairman during the year.

Members

Sri M. U. Ahmad, Mukhya Nagar Adhikari, Lucknow, was succeeded by Sri R. R. Shah.

Training

- (A) A short term course on 'Productivity in Municipal Administration' was conducted for the senior municipal executives from July 8 to 16, 1974. The objectives of the course were as follows:—
 - (i) to underline the need for increasing the administrative efficiency in municipal government within the existing resources; and
 - (ii) to acquaint the municipal officers with the techniques and tools for promoting administrative efficiency.

A list of participants to the course in given in Appendix I and the list of speakers in Appendix II.

- (B) The Seventeenth In-service Training programme of six-weeks' duration was organised for newly recruited municipal officers of class III and class IV Poards from November 18, 1974 to December 29, 1971. The list of participants is given in Appendix III. Apart from the faculty members, a good number of guest speakers addressed the participants on various aspects of municipal government. The list of guest speakers and the subjects of discussion are given in Appendix IV and V respectively.
- (C) The Centre conducted an eight-day workshop on 'Municipal Taxation and Recoveries' from Octoder 3 to 10, 1974. The main objectives of this workshop were as under:—
 - (i) identification of the problems in tax administration;
 - (ii) exchange of views on various aspects of municipal taxation and recoveries; and
 - (iii) to suggest measures for improving the system of taxation.

The workshop was attended to by the officers directly connected with the tax administration. A list of officers who attended the workshop is given in Appendix VI. The following taxes were taken up for detailed examination:

- (i) Property tax;
- (ii) Octroi, terminal and toll taxes;
- (iii) Minor taxes and non-tax revenues; and
- (iv) Collection, supervision and vigilance of municipal taxes.

Separate study groups were constituted for the purpose of discussion. Each group was guided by an expert assisted by the members of the faculty. Following persons were associated with the study groups:—

- Sri K. S. Sinha, Dy. Secretary, Finance, Government of Uttar Fradesh, Lucknow.
- 2. Sri S. C. Khanna, Retd. Dy. Secretary, L. S. G. of Uttar Pradesh Government, Lucknow.

- 4. Sri P. R Tripathi, Asstt. Director, Local Bodies, U. P. Government, Lucknow.

The recommendations of the workshop have been circulated to the various local bodies for their commenst. After receiving the comments, the same will be published.

(D) Three workshops on Municipal Budgeting of three day's duration each were also organised by the Centre. They were attended to by the officers-in-charge, Local Bodies, and Local Body Clerks, the Executive Officers and Accountants. The objective of these workshops was to make the municipal personnel aware of making a realistic and sound budget.

Eighty-four officials participated in these courses. A list of the participants is given in Appendix VII.

Research

- (A) The Centre had undertaken the study of the Administrative History of class I towns of Uttar Pradesh in the previous year. The study includes a detailed analysis of the municipal administration of these towns. The history of two towns has been completed. The collection of material for the other towns is in progress.
- (B) The Centre has submitted two research proposals to the Indian Council of Social Sciences Research. The proposals relate to the working of the Calcutta Metropolitan Development Authority and of the Panchayati Raj Bodies of U. P. The study on the working of CMDA is proposed

to be made under the guidance of Sri K. K. Dass, I. C. S. (Retired) and will extend over a period of eleven months. The study of the Panchayati Raj bodies will consist of an examination of the working of five Zila Parishads, ten Kshetra Samitis and 20 Gram Panchayats. Various aspects of the Panchayati Raj administration will be examined in details. The study is likely to extend over the period of one and a half year. This study is likely to throw a fresh light on the important area of Rural - Urban relationship in the State.

Diploma in Urban Government and Administration

The course was started with a view to provide necessary pre-service training to candidates who wish to enter local government service. It has been popular and is proving useful.

Library

To cater to the growing requirements of trainee officers and research workers in the field of local government, urban planning and allied areas, a separate section has been created. This section has been strengthened considerably through the grants from the Central Government and also from the Government of Uttar Pradesh. The Library has also started the indexing af microliterature.

Budget

The Budget of the Centre as given in Appendix VIII, was approved by the Advisory Committee at its meeting held on July 27, 1974.

Grants

(i) The Government of Madhya Pradesh had sanctioned a recurring grant of Rs. 5,000/- during 1973-74. However, till the close of the financial year, i. e. 1974-75, this recurring grant was not made available to the Centre.

- (ii) The Government of Uttar Pradesh sanctioned Rs. 1,34,284/- as recurring and Rs. 64,716/- as nonrecurring grants during the year.
- (iii) The Government of India has enhanced the recurring grant from Rs. 85,000/- to Rs. 1 55 lakh This has helped the Centre in stabilising its financial position to a considerable extent.
